4. Consent Agenda-
 - A. Approval of the minutes from March 25, 2019 Council meeting.
Warden made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Sellard seconded. Motion carried 4/0.

 - A. Insurance-change deductibles-1 quote for \$1000 deductible savings per year \$463.00 and 1 quote for \$3000 deductible savings per year \$1,253.00. Have only Fire Truck and Patrol car on full coverage.
 - B. CMB Ordinance adoption Ord. No. 943.
Warden made a motion to approve ordinance No. 943. Jones seconded. Motion carried 3/1 Sellard abstained.
 - C. Semi ordinance 702-Chief Hager talked to a resident in violation of this ordinance. Last sentence on Section 1, with the weight came into question. Wanted to know if council wanted to change or leave as is. Last line of first section states "Any truck of greater rated capacity tractor, truck-tractor, trailer, semi-trailer is expressly prohibited.

People keep throwing wood out there that shouldn't be in there. Side walk by Keller Leopold needs fixed near water meter. Guys will check into it. Key Equipment would like to come next Tuesday or Wednesday to do a demo. 2010 overhauled 3 years ago, will overhaul again possibly around 100,000.00 range.
