RESOLUTION NO. 2021-003 REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BUCKLIN, KANSAS, TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Bucklin, was calculated as 83.215 mills by the Ford County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Bucklin, will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on August 23, 2021, allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Bucklin, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BUCKLIN:

The City of Bucklin shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 85.674 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
