

RESOLUTION 2024-009

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE SALES TAX BALLOT MEASURE AS PRESENTED TO AND APPROVED BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF BUCKLIN ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, IMPOSING A SPECIAL ONE PERCENT (1%) CITYWIDE RETAILERS' SALES TAX

WHEREAS, Resolution 2024-004, previously passed by the City Council on August 19, 2024, authorized the County Clerk of Ford County, who is the County's Election Officer, to present a special one percent (1%) citywide retailers' sales tax question on the November 5, 2024 general election ballot; and

WHEREAS, the question, as presented in the aforementioned Resolution, asked whether such special retailers' sales tax should commence on January 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the question, as presented to the voters on November 5, 2024, asked whether such special retailers' sales tax should commence on April 1, 2025.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BUCKLIN, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: The City Council adopts and approves the language of the one percent retailers' sales tax as presented to the voters of the City of Bucklin and approved by the same by affirmative ballots cast on November 5, 2024.

SECTION TWO: The City Council will work with the Kansas Department of Revenue and other organizations and individuals as necessary to implement the will of the voters as expressed through their ballots, including commencement of the special one percent (1%) retailers' sales tax on April 1, 2025.

SO APPROVED by the Governing Body of the City of Bucklin, Kansas, this 18th day of November, 2024, a majority voting in favor thereof.


